Data Review -

- Navigating eduCLIMBER regarding incidents (2024-2025 top minor: non-compliance & top major: physical aggression)
 - Consistent with the previous school year data
- Responses to incidents restorative chats were the most common with required breaks as a close second
 - Consistent with the previous school year data
- Breaking it down further. October was the highest incidents
 - Tuesday was the highest day during the week for incidents
 - With 10:00-12:00 being the highest times for incidents
 - Classrooms were reported by location where the highest incidents have occurred
- ADD: Removal as a primary response into eduCLIMBER
- The plan is to refine the use of eduCLIMBER to obtain data to properly understand the *why* and have consistency across all grade levels in terms of data input

ADSIS - Admin will delegate authority to the ADSIS staff and the educators. This will allow staff to navigate quicker and begin support sooner.
