- **eduCLIMBER**
 - Questions: How will we use it as a school? What do we want to track? Should only one or two persons be in charge of inputting the data?
 - The program is very customizable and can be adjusted to suit our school's specific needs.
 - Transferring referrals into the digital platform
 - Changing language on form (update as the language matters)
 - Input data - Fastbridge, MCA test scores, socioeconomics, etc.
 - Incidents:
 - modify the location (specific places around the school instead of generalizing), time of day
 - Code - what happened
 - Perceived Motivation - (antecedent) that led to this referral
 - Additional notes for commenting on specifics of incident
 - Response - what will be done afterwards
 - Parent Contact
 - How will teachers be able to record incidents - what will be the easiest medium for them to use without overwhelming staff
 - Paper form, Google Forms, eduCLIMBER
 - Next steps:
 - Create Google Form for staff (Assessment & Data committee)

- Build intervention language (when/then, break, restorative circle, etc. - EBS committee)
- Lock down targeted behaviors to trial run the program (work refusal?)
