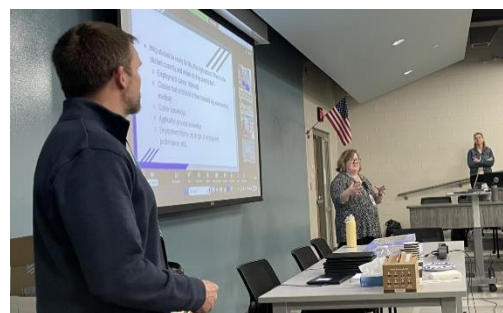
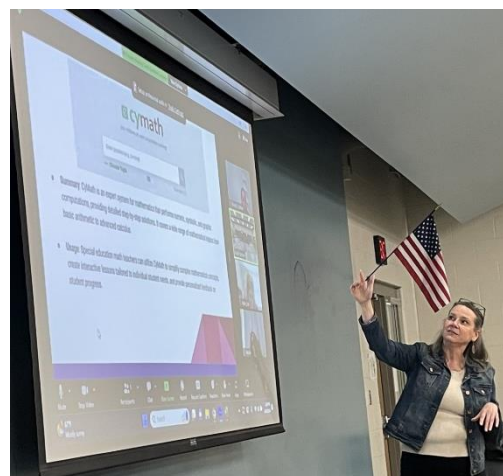
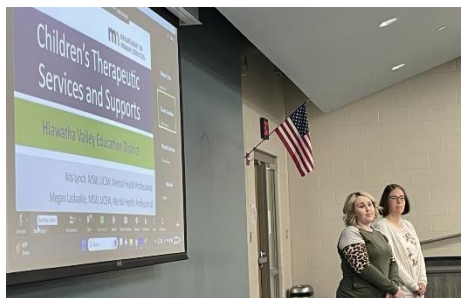


**Principals' Advisory Council (PAC)**
