Archery time again!

We are excited to offer again our very own Bluffview Montessori archery club this year. We will be working with two groups of students again to build confidence and skills necessary for range and tourney play. Due to after school activities during the week, there is a changeup to the timeline and days:

- Archery club will run **Saturday's Starting January 29th - March 5th 2022**
- Saturday Jan 29th: **All** archers report for an orientation on safety and expectations.
 - 4th&5th grade arrive for check-in and ready to go by 10am. Please bring permission slips if they have not been returned yet.
 - 6th,7th,8th archers arrive for check-in and ready to go by 11am. Please bring permission slips if they have not been returned yet.
 - Grade 4&5 archers shoot from 10:30a-11a
 - Grade 6,7,8 archers shoot from 11:30a-12noon
- Each Saturday following Jan. 29th, times will be as follows;
 - Grade 4 & 5 archers begin shooting (regular day) @10a-11a
 - Grade 6, 7 & 8 archers begin shooting @11a-12pm noon.
 - **Saturday, February 26th** tournament at Ridgeway
- The club will run until Spring Break

Other information:

E2's & Erdkinder students will be conducting basic archery lessons during their PE class time starting **January 24th (Monday)**. At this time, please check box below if you give your child permission to participate during PE class time while archery is in session.

For Archery Club, there are at least 2 adult chaperones scheduled each Saturday, and there will always be one that has taken the Basic Instructors Training through NASP.

Please remind your child that they are to bring a book or other appropriate items to occupy themselves between rounds as we have traditionally had 2 rotating groups each day.

Please also bring a mask to wear as we will be on-site.

There will be a fee of \$10.00 this year to cover equipment. Please turn in the permission slip (below) to the office along with the fee by the end of the day Thursday the 27th. No individuals will shoot without a permission slip.

Behavior expectations mirror those of the school day. Any students choosing to act disrespectfully or in a way that creates an unsafe archery environment will be dismissed from the group.
