In order to get ready for our first day together, we would like to ask that you gather a few things to bring to your "get acquainted" meeting or to our open house.

SUPPLIES:

- backpack for daily use (standard size), labeled with child's name
- family photo (4x6 or 5x7) *no frame
- individual photo of your child (not in a frame)
- 1 **labeled** spill-free water bottle
- 1 box of 24-count washable wide-type markers
- 1 box of 24-count colored pencils
- 1 box of 24-count crayons
- 1 Kleenex box
- 1 bottle of sunscreen labeled with child's name
- 2 Clorox wipes
- at least one labeled set of seasonal clothing
- 1 **small** potted house plant **labeled** with child's name and type of plant (for plant care and in case of ingestion)
- 1 pair of plain slippers (please no character/animal head)
- 1 labeled coloring book (for indoor recess)

- 1 box of **ivory** soap (3-year-olds only)
- 1 set of pink erasers (3-year-olds only)
- 1 box of business envelopes (3-year-olds only)
- 1 package of glue sticks (4-year-olds only)
- 1 package of napkins (4-year-olds only)
- 1 watercolor paint (kindergarten only)
- 1 pair tie gym shoes (kindergarten only)

*If your child is a full day Children's House/Kindergarten student who needs to nap please remember to bring one small pillow, one small blanket, and one small stuffed animal that will fit on the bottom shelf of their hall cubby.

Everyone please bring the following items:

For individual use:

For the convenience of families and to ensure that students have the correct supplies needed for our classroom systems, we have bulk purchased notebooks and folders to be purchased from the school. The set of notebooks and folders that we purchased for each student costs \$10.00. These items will be given to students either on orientation day or the first day of school. Please bring your payment to the office when you bring your child's other school supplies.

***4th:** 1 container Clorox wipes, 2 rolls of Scotch tape, craft sticks, sticky notes

***6th:** Napkins, fine tip Expo markers (a 2-4 pack), pencil top erasers, highlighters

Students are encouraged to reuse any materials from previous years.

Personal Supplies:

Pencil case that will hold the writing materials below (small or fabric cases fit best in cubbies):

Pencils (extra lead and extra erasers if mechanical)

Pencil sharpener (if you purchase wood pencils)

Pens-black or blue

Highlighters (at least two colors)

Colored pencils

A regular and a ultra fine Sharpie (Black)

1 composition notebook - Personal World (8th grade may reuse)

1 book cover or paper bag for math textbook

1 folder for each class (5 classes) some students prefer 1 folder with multiple sections. (please no binders)

1 1.5" binder for portfolio/immersion (8th grade can reuse)

1 Scientific Calculator (optional we have classroom calculators)

- example models: TI-30X IIS, TI-30XS(preferred), Casio fx-300MS

These calculators range from \$8.00 to \$15.00. If students take care of them, the calculator should last them into high school.

Grades 1-8 only

1st grade and new students

New Sketchbook - 40+ pages, size approximately 8"x 10"

Please write the student's first and last name and classroom on the cover of the sketchbook before bringing it to school.

1st through 8th grades:

- Each student should bring in a \$5.00 Art fee. Please designate "Art" (\$5 to be dropped off at the front office desk)

The following should be labeled for Art:

- 1st graders: 1 pack of glue sticks
- 2nd graders: 1 bottle of Elmer's liquid glue
- 3rd graders: 1 pack of Crayola conical tip markers-colors can vary
- 4th graders: 1 or 2 rolls of scotch tape or masking tape, or blue paint tape
- 5th graders: 1 pack of fine point black sharpies
- 6th graders: 1 pack of extra fine point black sharpies
- 7th graders: 1 pack of colored fine point sharpies
- 8th graders: 1 pack of colored extra fine point sharpies

*Donations of large/extra large plastic ziplock baggies are also appreciated for projects.

All Sketchbooks If your child kept their sketchbook at school over the summer there is no need to purchase a new sketchbook. If your child took it home and it is in good condition and it has at least 25-30 blank pages please do not purchase a new one. Just return that one to school. A new sketchbook will only need to be purchased if your child used theirs up, or misplaced it over the summer.
