Title IX Policy Updates

- ➤ New regulations effective August 14, 2020
- ➤ Schools must:
 - a. Have a board approved policy and grievance process (will submit new policy for review for next board meeting)
 - b. Identify a Title IX Coordinator (Sherry Lohmeyer)
 - c. Offer supportive measure to complainant that "restore or preserve equal access to education program"
 - d. Post training materials and coordinator's contact info on website and include in handbook
- ➤ Complainant or complainant's parent (if dependent) must file written complainant or ask Title IX coordinator to file on his/her behalf
- ➤ Schools must have a designated Title IX Coordinator, Investigator, Decision Maker and Appeals Decision Maker
- > Respond to report of sexual harassment in a manner that is not deliberately indifferent

Distance Learning Curriculum Update

➤ Distance-learning coordinator to work directly with opt-in families and serve as contact for classroom teachers

The distance-learning coordinator would individual learning progressions for students, facilitate online content, communicate with families and teachers, attend IEP meetings as necessary, etc.

- ➤ We are considering the program Pathblazer by the company Edgenuity: "Pathblazer is an online program that prescribes individualized learning progressions with fun, motivating content that addresses skill and concept gaps." It is a K-8 program with a math, reading, science, and social studies scope and sequence.
- ➤ Teachers may communicate with families, provide supplemental Montessori-based curriculum, and offer online social opportunities at will, but the coordinator position is intended to alleviate the primary curricular burden off on-site staff.
- ➤ Site license: \$7995.00 and individual license: \$75.00.
