2. Annual Report - World's Best Workforce
 - a. 2015-2019 MCA Proficiency - trend line can be volatile with our small sample
 - b. Math followed state trend of going down, reading stayed higher than state
 - c. Science volatility is way more varied, as only so few students in the school are tested
 - d. Sub Groups show the gap reduction is the focus here, though we don't have large enough groups (supposed to have 20 students minimum)
 - e. Attendance - based on 90% attendance now. We have 84% of our students at 90% attendance
 - f. FastBridge, CBMR, Early Math, Early Reading reports available in Google Docs - show every grade level compared to national percentiles
 - g. What else do we want to see?
 - h. Can we have some record of what we are doing differently this year to show we are trying to raise math scores for next year?
