



PARENTING TEENS

SOCIAL MEDIA, SMART PHONES AND TEENS: THE FOUR P'S

ON AVERAGE, TEENS SPEND 7.7 HOURS PER DAY ON SCREEN TIME UNRELATED TO SCHOOLWORK, AND ONE-THIRD OF TEENS REPORTED BEING CYBERBULLIED. YET, SOCIAL MEDIA, ONLINE FORUMS, AND TEXTING PROVIDE TEENS WITH WAYS TO CONNECT WITH OTHERS THAT THEY MAY NOT HAVE IN THEIR OWN SCHOOL OR PERSONAL COMMUNITIES.
