

Early Childhood Screening

Early Childhood Screening is important for your child's continued learning and readiness for future school success.

Minnesota state law requires all preschoolers be screened PRIOR to entering public school Kindergarten. Screening is preferred at age 3, but can be done at 4 or 5 years old.

What happens during a screening?

- Vision & Hearing
- Growth
- Immunization Status
- Skills in thinking, communication and language, large and small muscles, and social/emotional development

When and where are the screenings held?

- Goodview Elementary School (Early Childhood Wing)

- Appointments available on select Thursday afternoons
- Each screening takes approximately 1-2 hours
