HVED Closed on the Winona Mall on April 16, 2024

The closing for the Winona Mall at 1213 Gilmore Avenue, Winona, MN took place at 11 AM on Tuesday, April 16, 2024 at Town n' Country Title with Amy Kostner facilitating the closing with Ron Pagel, Board Chair and Christine Troendle, Board Clerk, as authorized signers for HVED. This moment was the culmination of a search that began over a decade ago that included a facility study in 2018 for a site that all member districts would support. That effort was realized when all 12-member district school boards passed the Winona Mall Joint Powers Agreement in October 2023. Then with the







assistance of several local, city, and state governmental agencies, legal and financial institutions, and the great efforts of several of HVED's Board Members, Superintendents, and Cabinet Members, the closing was accomplished. This event marks the beginning of the planning phase for all HVED programs: a PAES Lab; the River Valley Academy Area Learning Center; SAIL Behavior Program; SPECTRUM Autism Program and the District Office to come together onto one common site.





After closing, letters that had been prepared with legal counsel and edited by Bradley Carlton, Business Manager, and Mackenzie Rollinger, District Office Administrative Assistant, pictured at left, were delivered to all lease holders within the former Winona Mall.
