

## Statutory Website Requirements per VOA Governance Oversight Doc

Statutory Requirement
124E.07 Subd. 8.(b) A charter school shall publish and maintain on the school's official <i>Web site</i> : (1) the meeting minutes of the board of directors and of members and committees having board-delegated authority, for at least 365 days from the date of publication;
124E.07 Subd. 8.(b) A charter school shall publish and maintain on the school's official <i>Web site</i> : (2) directory information for the board of directors and for the members of committees having board-delegated authority;
124E.07 Subd. 8.(b) A charter school shall publish and maintain on the school's official <i>Web site</i> : (3) identifying and contact information for the school's authorizer.
124E.11 Subd. 3 (b) The charter school must develop and publish, including on its <i>Web site</i> , a lottery policy and process that it must use when accepting pupils by lot.
124E.13 Subd. 3. (b) (3) post on the school <i>Web site</i> the name, mailing address, bylaws, minutes of board meetings, and names of the current board of directors of the affiliated nonprofit building corporation
124E.16 Subd. 2. Annual public reports. (a).... A charter school must post the annual report on the school's official <i>Web site</i> .
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124E.12 (b) A charter school board or a cooperative of teachers that provides group health insurance coverage must establish and publish on its <i>Web site</i> the policy for purchasing group health insurance coverage. A charter school board policy must include a sealed proposal process, which requires all proposals to be opened at the same time. Upon opening the proposals according to the school or cooperative policy, the proposals become public data under chapter 13.
